DONATION DRIVE DETAILS...

Easter Seals Wisconsin provides services to children and adults with disabilities and support to their families. One of the ways they do this is by providing respite camps throughout the course of the year. These camps, located at the Wisconsin Elks Association campground in the Wisconsin Dells, give campers with special needs the ability to experience their very own summer camp experience in an environment that is supportive of their physical and/or cognitive limitations. We have personally benefited from the services provided by Easter Seals and would love to give back by providing them with many of the items they need to accommodate campers throughout the year.

The camp has some very specific needs. Please take a look at the list to the right and bring an item or two (or ten or more!) to help the camp stock up for the season!

In addition, African Youth Outreach, our charity from last year will be back to help out with our crafts. A list of their needs are included too!

THE MOST IMPORTANT DONATION ITEMS

- Wet Wipes** – They go through 5 cases (not boxes, cases) of wipes during a week of special needs camps. This is their biggest ongoing need.
- Weather Radios** – Specifically the one model that is sold at Radio Shack. These are necessary for each cabin.
- Cash for 2-way radios** – They need more 2 way radios, but it would be better to give cash towards them so they can buy ones that are compatible with their current radios.
- Tarps** – 10'X12' or larger.
- Sleeping bags** – Summer weight adult
- Wooden and plastic beads** – need thousands, mostly smaller. Also need easy to thread beads.
- Paintbrushes** – for crafts
- Masking tape** – used for everything
- Scotch tape**
- Colored copy paper** – for the camp newsletters.
- Duct tape** – especially the colorful stuff.
- Tempura paints** – the really big jars.
- Sidewalk chalk**
- Sun Screen** – spf 30 or higher spray on lotion is best.
- Popsicle/craft sticks**
- First Aid Supplies** – you name it, they need it.
- Surgical Gloves** – latex & powder free.

OTHER DONATION ITEMS

Here are some other items the camp needs: CD Boom Boxes, board games, craft buttons, a digital camera, and dehumidifiers.

African Youth Outreach: In addition to the needs of the Easter Seals special needs camps, African Youth Outreach needs the following items - pens, pencils (not mechanical), magic markers, fabric pencil cases (not the hard cases), and watercolor sets.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SWE PARTY 2007!

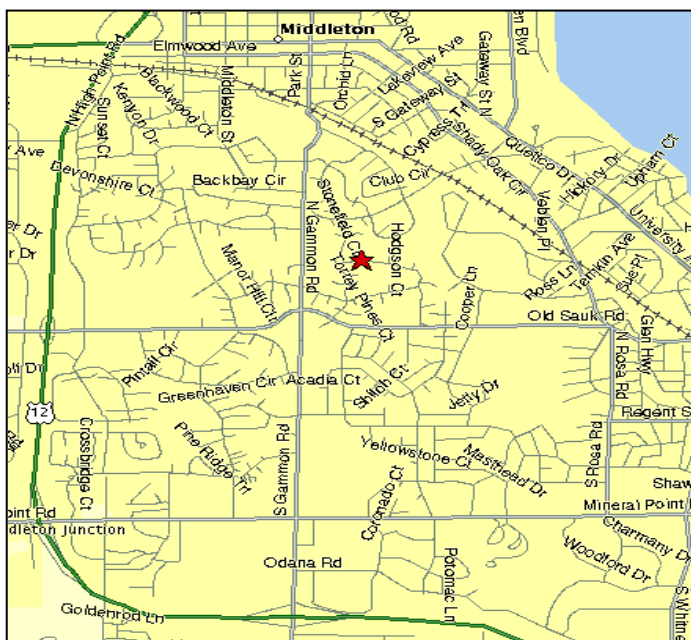
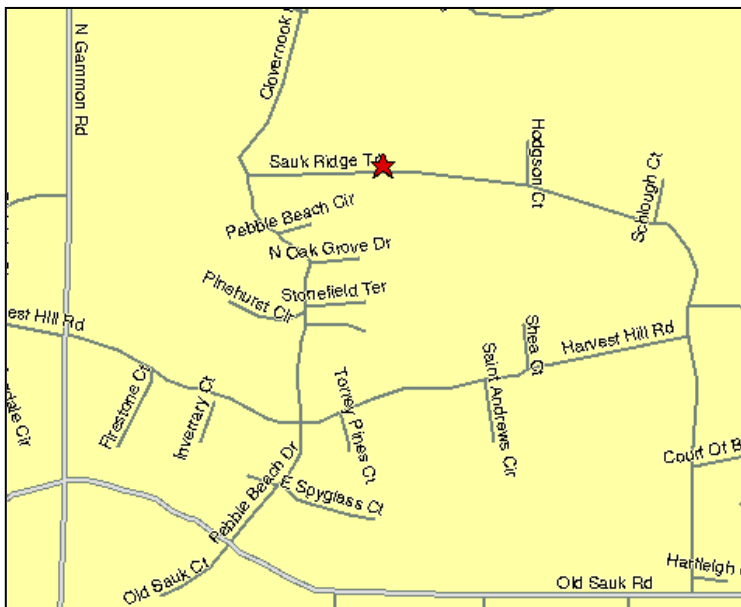
From West Towne Mall, go North on Gammon (past the high school).
